WE HAVE MADE A CHANGE

At the Feb show we tried out a new set up for the timed events to help with the flow of horses in and out of the ring. It worked so well that the board has voted to use this same set up for all classes at the March

show. In place of entering at the main gate, contestants will enter at the side gate and assemble in a holding area at the East end of the arena. For the jumping, trail, ranch riding pattern and timed classes contestants will enter the holding area and then enter the main part of the ring one by one. For all other classes you will all enter as the class is called. One adult per contestant will be allowed in the holding area. In order for the new set up to flow easily there will be no parking allowed from the SHA shed to the East end of the arena. This will allow horses to enter and exit the arena easily.

In case you are uncertain as to which is the East end of the arena; the booth is on the South side and the bleachers are on the North side.

We welcome your thoughts and suggestions on this new flow and look forward to using it at the March show to help with the flow of horses in and out of the arena.

PATTERNS

Pattern sets are A, B, C, D, and E. They will be used Feb – June in order and then repeated June- Nov also in order.

YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING IN ORDER TO ENTER.

1. **SHA MEMBERSHIP**
2. **PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS. YOU CAN EITHER BRING A COPY OF THE COGGINS AND PUT IT IN THE COPY NOTEBOOK OR WRITE THE INFORMATION IN THE OTHER NOTEBOOK. IF FILING A COPY PLEASE FILE IT IN THE MONTH OF EXPIRATION**
3. **ONE LONG SHEET WITH CLASSES MARKED PER PERSON/HORSE COMBINATION. DON'T FORGET YOUR NUMBER!**
4. **ONE SHORT SHEET FOR EACH CLASS. DON'T FORGET YOUR NUMBER!**
5. **ALL FORMS ARE ON THE WEBSITE AND CAN BE DOWNLOADED AND FILLED OUT ON YOUR COMPUTER. THIS WILL SAVE YOU A LOT OF TIME**
